## 2012 P.C.T.C. Hall of Fame

**Ed Ferree**...Ed is a car owner, driver, sponsor and motorsports business owner. He has owned and raced both dirt and asphalt race cars, racing them both on local tracks as well as nationally on Busch Grand National, Cup and ARCA tracks. He owns Alex Ferree's car that won three Lernerville Speedway Late Model Championships. He is the owner of Franklin Racing Supply and ADC Die Cast Collectibles and sponsors cars across the country. Ed has a major impact in the local racing community.

**Dick Thomas**...Dick started his racing career as a car owner of a Claimer in the early 60's. When he started driving himself, he won numerous races and finished second in points on several occasions at Heidelberg and South Park. He competed in the Claiming division for 3 years and then moved into Late Models. In the late 60's Dick moved to the Mini Stock division and competed at tracks all around the region winning feature races and the Clinton Speedway championship in 1970. Following his retirement from driving, Dick became a car owner again; John Johnson, Norm Benning Jr., Alex "Bunty" Makar, Augie Sandman and Blackie Watt drove for him. He won championships at Motordrome and Jennerstown. His son Ricky drove for him and won the Limited Late championship at Pittsburgh in 1994. Ricky was a top 5 competitor in the Late Models with a best finish of second at PMS.

**Bud Garvey**...Bud started racing in 1962. In 1964 alone he won 30 plus features at Houtzsale, Clearfield and Mahaffey Speedways which were promoted by the Drivers Owners Racing Association. Bud retired from racing in 1977 with over 200 feature wins. In 2002 he started his museum in Osceola Mills, PA. The museum contains many of the cars he drove over the years. The museum holds a party each July in which all his cars are on display as well as hundreds of race cars and Street Rods restored by others. Bud was an innovator and very talented often testing the talents of track officials.

**Albert "Ouch" Roenigk**...Ouch's years of dedication and hard work have increased enjoyment, competition and safety for fans and race teams at Lernerville. He was made Track Manager in 1972 and eventually wore many hats. Always resourceful; he bought loads of steel beams and angle iron from demolished steel mills and recycled these items and used them to build bleachers, catch fences, scoreboard and billboards for advertising for the speedway. Ouch was an expert at grading and maintaining the track surface for safe and competitive racing and was often consulted by other tracks across the country. He was the first to string multiple cables through the catch fence and now all tracks, including super speedways, are required by insurance companies to construct similar cable fences for safety. He was the first to build corporate boxes at a short track. It was Ouch's idea to construct a Gauntlet truck which greatly improved safety for the enduro races.

## 2013 Points

## **Pittsburgh Circle Track Club Racers Reunion 21 and Under Racers Challenge**

Eligibility age 21 and under

Must be a 2013 dues paid member of the Pittsburgh Circle Track Club

Must be a dirt or asphalt competitor in the Young Guns/4-Cylinder type, Amateur (Hobby Stocks/Chargers) or Street Stock type cars to eligible

Must race the entire 2013 race season with Pittsburgh Circle Track Club Racers Reunion sticker (s) on car (provided by the club) – in location(s) designated by the club and not to interfere with track or sponsorship decal locations

Must attend (the entire day) the 2013 Pittsburgh Circle Track Club Racers Reunion at the Heidelberg Volunteer Fire Department Firehall in November from 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m.

Active participation in the Pittsburgh Circle Track Club – attend some meetings, attend some functions
